The Journal of Negro Education improves Impact Factor and Rankings according to the SCImago Journal Rank

The Journal of Negro Education improved its impact score to **0.26**; up from 0.13 in the previous year. Furthermore, in 2011 JNE ranked 44 out of 118 among all social science and cultural journals in the United States. Today, JNE's ranking is **15 out of 123**. JNE ranks **3rd** among Black American journals: *The Journal of Black Psychology* ranks 1st and *Journal of Black Studies* ranks 2nd.

The extension is for another two weeks which should facilitate ample time for a more thorough review. I also would like reviewers to advise that if after they accept the manuscript to find out that they cannot review it for whatever reason, let me know as well. The sooner I am informed, the quicker the manuscript can be reassigned.
